The Farm Progress Show is coming up from **August 27 - August 29, 2024**. The **Farm Progress Show** occurs at the **Central Iowa Expo Center at 1827 217th Street in Boone County**. Because of the large number of people this show attracts, there will be traffic-related issues all three days, both for those attending the show and those who travel through the area to/from work. Everyone can expect traffic congestion, possible delays and road closures on Hwy 30, eastern Mamie Eisenhower Ave., and the Highway 30 intersection at Cpl. Snedden Road (Airport Road) and Quill Ave. The Crown Flair (Moffitt's Ford) crossover will be **CLOSED** all three days in the afternoons from 4:00-6:00 pm.

Alternate routes are **STRONGLY SUGGESTED**, and citizens should **AVOID THESE AREAS ALL THREE DAYS OF THE SHOW**.

Semi-truck traffic traveling northbound on Highway 17, intending to head westbound on Highway 30, should consider taking 270th Street to L Ave and connecting to Highway 30 from L Ave.

We understand these traffic changes are a nuisance to the public, but with your cooperation, we will limit the number of traffic accidents and injuries during this event. Citizens are encouraged to call the Boone Police Department at 515-432-3456 for assistance planning their commutes to and from Boone during these dates.

2. S/B AND N/B Airport Rd. / Quill Ave.. crossover at Hwy 30 **CLOSED** all 3 days **4:00pm – 6:00pm.**



3. Crown Flair (Moffitt's Ford) crossover will be **closed** all 3 days **4:00pm-6:00pm.**
